



THE INDUS RECREATION CENTRE

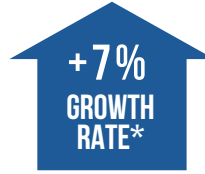
The Bow Valley Agricultural Society (BVAS) was formed by a group of dedicated volunteers in 1974 with the responsibility of operating and maintaining the Indus Recreation Center. For over 40 years this volunteer-run organization has successfully managed, operated and expanded the facility to meet the needs of southeast Rocky View communities through a collaborative partnership with Rocky View County. Today there are both new community members as well as descendants of the original group still maintaining the integrity of our association

The role of the Bow Valley Agricultural Society is to encourage community spirit for individuals and families living in our rural community through integrity and professionalism, by developing and maintaining facilities, enabling volunteers, and supporting programs & related services to meet community needs.

The Indus Recreation Centre currently hosts an ice arena, 450-person hall, baseball diamonds, soccer field, riding arena, meeting rooms, catering service, concession, and preschool. It has a working relationship with the Bow Valley Curling Club that manages the lounge and curling club.

OUR COMMUNITY

Indus Recreation Centre serves the South East quadrant of Rocky View County which is referred to as Division 6 and includes the Bow North Recreational District.



There is immediate demand by both minor and adult sport organizations for more ice. Our minor sports programs have successfully increased programming at the Indus Recreation Centre to the maximum time we have available.

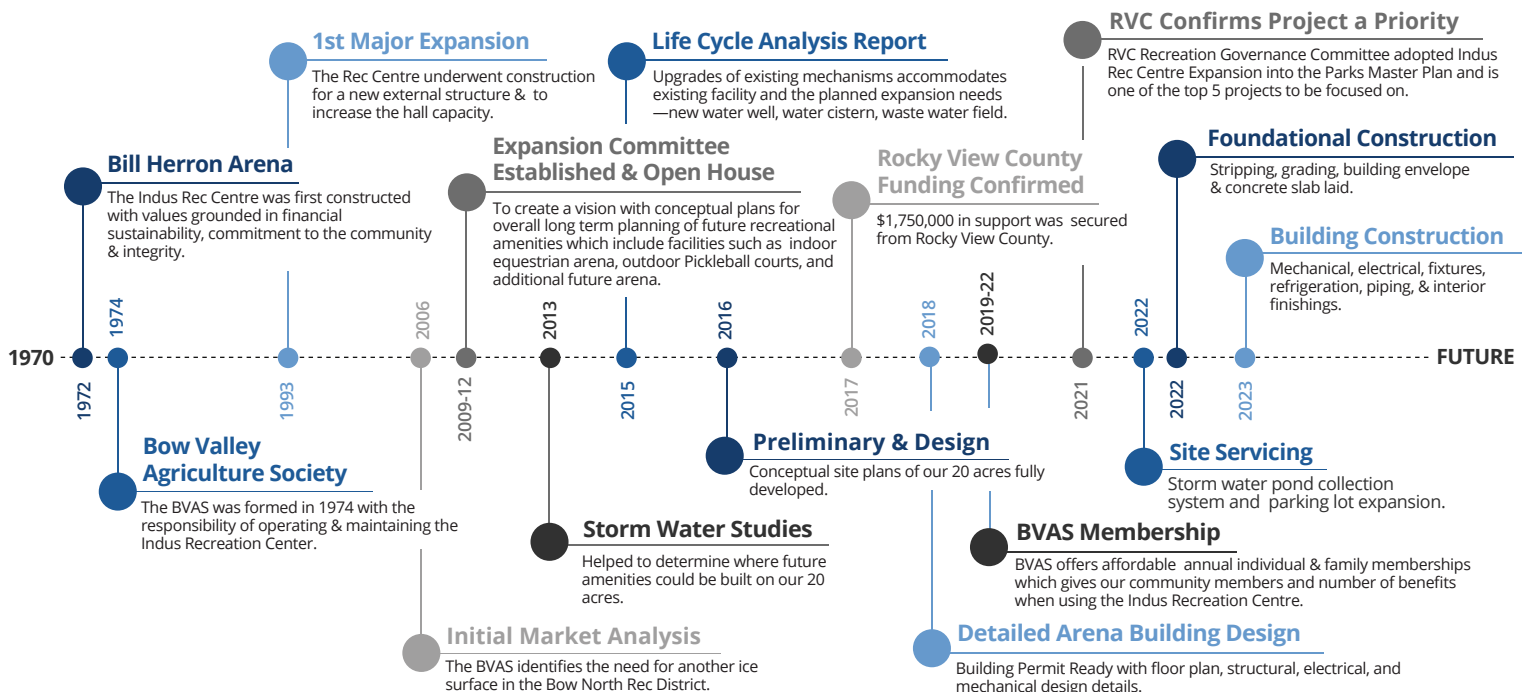

INDUS RECREATION CENTRE EXPANSION PROJECT

Expansion of the existing recreation center includes:

- NHL sized ice surface
- Dressing Rooms to accommodate co-ed teams
- Washrooms
- Seating Area
- Additional Parking
- Storm Drainage / Firefighting Lagoon
- General Site Improvements

Demand for ice within the Bow North Recreation Area is at an all-time high and local Ice times are in short supply. With support from our minor sports groups and interest from nearby associations, BVAS recognizes that now is the ideal time to expand the Indus Rec Center.

STEP 1

Planning & Funding

Work with user groups, County partners, and engineering consultants to design for community needs.

Site Preparation

Prepare the site for construction by adding stormwater infrastructure and developing site grading.

Stripping, grading, building envelope & concrete slab laid (if grant funding is secured).

Mechanical, electrical, fixtures, refrigeration, piping, & interior finishings.

ENVIRONMENT IMPACT



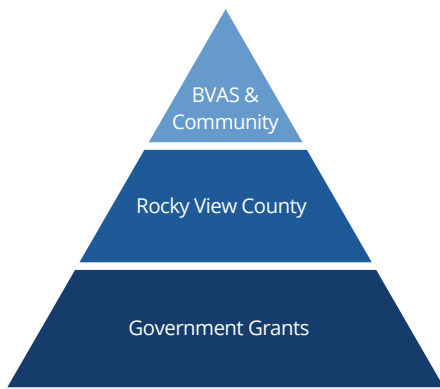
REDUCE EMISSIONS

Water use will be more efficient as our ice melt pit will recirculate water for ice flood. Storm water collected on site will be reused and the local wetlands will remain intact & protected.
